

The Founder's Conversation Starter






As I assume all of you know, this year has begun for us here in Los Angeles with hurricane force winds igniting fires that raged through neighborhoods turning lifetimes into ash and memories. It is an incomprehensible level of destruction that is much more absolute than anything I have ever seen before. A remarkably beautiful part of Los Angeles burned down to the brick chimneys that now stand like failed sentinels standing watch over where memories were made. All this destruction made all the more agonizing by the fact there was a 117million-gallon reservoir drained and empty in close proximity. Though we cannot control the winds and wayes that throw their occasional tantrums causing countless loss of lives and treasure, our role as human beings is to co-create what we cherish as valuable and to protect those we treasure. Part of that responsibility is to keep the reservoirs full.

When I first learned of human trafficking I was confronted by a degree of suffering and betrayal of those most vulnerable and valuable that I could not turn away and be content with my "awareness". My intolerance of this man-made catastrophe, drove me to focus on prevention and disrupting the flow of the vulnerable into the bondage of their would-be exploiters. What propelled me forward in this effort for over a decade now is the vision of what we could be for each other, what each child could become, each boy and girl to man to woman to father to mother, the "peaceful transfer" of the generations increasingly defining us as a human family with our limitless curiosity and creativity to match an ever-expanding universe of magnificent mysteries! If we did a better job of "filling the reservoir", we would not be standing watch over what could have been of our beautiful home in the Palisades and Alta Dena, nor dare I say, our earthly home. When we keep the reservoirs topped off and ready, the challenges we face can be extinguished before the embers can pepper the landscape heartache and soot.

So how do we prevent threats to our families and homes, how do we keep the "reservoirs" full for before the winds rise and the blaze begins? When we are better equipped to meet anticipated challenges, we stand


